RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

1. Introduction

- 1.1 In line with Government policy to provide maximum autonomy to the Island of Rodrigues, the Rodrigues Regional Assembly was set up under Act 39 of 2001. The Assembly is a body corporate and the exercise of its functions is regarded as done on behalf of the Government of Mauritius. It is responsible, for the formulation and implementation of policy in respect of the Central Administration and the 47 departments of Rodrigues.
- 1.2 The Executive Council of the Regional Assembly, which is responsible for carrying out the functions of the Regional Assembly and for developing policy on matters relating to Rodrigues, comprises the Chief Commissioner, the Deputy Chief Commissioner and five Commissioners, who are responsible for exercising general direction and control over the Commission falling under their responsibility.
- 1.3 The Island Chief Executive is responsible for the efficient administration of all the functions of the Executive Council and the staff of the Regional Assembly works under his administrative control. He is empowered to exercise the functions of the Magistrate in his absence, of the Director of Environment in the enforcement of environmental laws and of the Tourism Authority in the enforcement of the Tourism Act.
- 1.4 The departments under the jurisdiction of the Regional Assembly have been grouped under the supervision of Departmental Heads who are public officers and Accounting Officers of their respective departments.
- 1.5 Following the coming into force of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly Act, the officers on the establishment of the Central Administration, Rodrigues and persons holding those offices have been transferred to the Regional Assembly and all rights, privileges and conditions of service incidental to such offices have been retained.
- 1.6 We have taken into consideration: "the physical separation of Rodrigues, its isolation, the restricted opportunities for employment and career fulfillment and the special needs of Rodrigues in view of its distinct identity" in making our recommendations.
- 1.7 We have strengthened a few structures with the creation of new grades particularly at the apex of departmental structures to take over responsibilities hitherto devolving on Mauritian counterparts. We have abolished a few grades which have now become redundant and restyled others to more

appropriate appellations. We have equally reviewed existing allowances and provided for specific conditions of service. It is expected that the combination of measures together with the pay structures and conditions of employment would enable the Rodriguan Civil Service to deliver effectively.

1.8 Our organisation and pay recommendations have been made for all grades, including the general services and the workmen group, departmentwise. The Master Conversion Table is given at Annex I.

2. Specific Conditions

2.1 We are giving in the ensuing paragraphs a few conditions which should apply specifically to Rodrigues.

Duty Free Concessions

2.2 The Clerk, Rodrigues Regional Assembly and the Departmental Heads have represented that owing to the topography of Rodrigues and its road network, they should be allowed to opt for duty remitted 4 x 4 vehicles. The Bureau is agreeable.

Recommendation 1

- 2.3 We recommend that the Clerk, Rodrigues Regional Assembly and the Departmental Heads, presently eligible for 100% duty free remission on cars, should be allowed to buy a 4 x 4 double cabin pick up vehicle, in lieu of a saloon car, under the provisions made at paragraph 15.2.37 of Volume I of this Report.
- 2.4 We have, during our visit in Rodrigues, received a number of representations for the privilege of loans on cars or motor cycles. We have confirmed during our site visits that officers do face transport difficulties more particularly for those working on late shift or roster because of the timetables of public transport or owing to the topography of the island. However, this does not apply to all officers in the same grade.

Recommendation 2

- 2.5 We recommend that Departmental Heads should identify in their respective Departments the officers who should be entitled for loans for the purchase of cars or motorcycles/autocycles as recommended at paragraphs 15.2.89 and 15.2.23 in Volume I of this Report. We have in mind more particularly, officers in the Fire Services, Health Section and Agriculture. The recommendations from the Heads of Department should be subject to the approval of the Chief Executive. It should also be binding upon the officers in receipt of such facilities to use their vehicle to attend work.
- 2.6 Lists of officers eligible for loans for the purchase of a 70% duty free car for official travelling and for loan to purchase duty free auto/motorcycles for official travelling are given as Annex II and III respectively.

Allowances

2.7 During our visit in Rodrigues, we have also received requests from several officers for the payment of varied allowances mainly for the performance of extraneous duties. These cases should be referred to the Ministry of Civil Service Affairs and Administrative Reforms by the Heads of Departments through the Chief Executive.

Rodriguan COLA

- 2.8 We have received numerous representations for the re-introduction of the Rodriguan COLA.
- 2.9 We had recommended in our 1998 Report that "the Central Statistical Office should conduct a study on the whole issue of computation of the differential in the cost of living between Mauritius and Rodrigues based on the appropriate comparison in patterns of expenditure."
- 2.10 We have analysed the results of the survey carried out by the Central Statistical Office and have come to the conclusion that there is no case for the reintroduction of the Rodriguan COLA.

Disturbance Allowance

2.11 It is a normal feature for Rodriguan Police Officers to be posted to Mauritius. We have received representations that Mauritian Police Officers posted to Rodrigues are granted 25% disturbance allowance while Rodriguan Police Officers working in Mauritius are not entitled to any allowance.

Recommendation 3

2.12 We recommend that a disturbance allowance of 25% should be paid to Rodriguan Police Officers posted in Mauritius.

Special Leave

2.13 At present, officers proceeding officially to Mauritius to participate in international/special events, are required to apply to the Ministry of Civil Service Affairs and Administrative Reforms for such special leave. It has been represented that, in the context of the setting up of the Regional Assembly, such leave should be devolved upon the Chief Executive. The Bureau concurs and recommends accordingly.

Walking Allowance

2.14 Certain categories of officers, such as Valve Operators, are required to walk during the performance of their duties because their places of work are not accessible by vehicles. These officers are paid a monthly allowance of Rs 90.

Recommendation 4

2.15 We recommend that the walking allowance be maintained and revised to Rs 100 monthly.

Walking Allowance to Attend Duty

2.16 Rodriguan Officers have to walk long distances for attending duty owing to the topography of the land and to the fact that their home places are inaccessible by buses or cars. Presently they are paid a walking allowance of Rs 90 a month.

Recommendation 5

2.17 We recommend that the monthly walking allowance payable to Rodriguan officers to attend duty be revised to Rs 100 wherever applicable.

Shift, Roster, Staggered Hours

2.18 A number of officers in a few grades in the different Commissions work on shift/roster or staggered hours. This element has been taken into account in arriving at the recommended salary for the grades.

Night Allowance

2.19 As an incentive to officers who are effectively performing night duty, we are introducing a night allowance.

Recommendation 6

2.20 We recommend that officers working on shift who effectively perform night duty, be paid for the period July 2003 to June 2004 a night allowance equivalent to 7.5% of the normal rate per hour for the hours worked between 2300 hours and 0500 hours excluding any lyingin hours. The rate shall be 10% of the hourly rate as from 1 July 2004.

Miscellaneous

Recommendation 7

2.21 We recommend that the allowance of 50% of salary of officers domiciled in Rodrigues and coming to Mauritius on training be maintained for the duration of the course.

2.22 We recommend the payment of an allowance of Rs 725 monthly as an assistance towards payment of rent to Rodriguan officers, coming to Mauritius on training, who cannot be provided with quarters.

Organisation and Pay Recommendations

3. Office of the Clerk

Sergeant at Arms

Recommendation

3.1 We recommend payment of an allowance of Rs 2000 monthly to the Police Officer performing the duties of Sergeant at Arms.

4. Chief Commissioner's Office

CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION

Island Secretary Deputy Island Secretary Assistant Island Secretary

4.1 Following the coming into force of the Regional Assembly, the grades of Island Secretary, Deputy Island Secretary and Assistant Island Secretary are no longer relevant as posts of Island Chief Executive, Departmental Heads and Administrative Officer have been created. However, two officers are still in post in the grade of Assistant Island Secretary. Consequently, we are maintaining the grade pending the integration of these officers in the newly created grade of Administrative Officer. The grades of Island Secretary and Deputy Island Secretary should be abolished.

Recommendation 1

- 4.2 We recommend that the grades of Island Secretary and Deputy Island Secretary be abolished.
- 4.3 We further recommend that the grade of Assistant Island Secretary be made evanescent and be abolished on vacancy.

Co-ordinating Officer, Rodrigues

4.4 The grade of Co-ordinating Officer, Rodrigues is vacant. Submission has been made for the restyling of the post to that of Administrative Officer. Since the post of Administrative Officer has already been created, we are abolishing the grade of Co-ordinating Officer, Rodrigues.

Recommendation 2

4.5 We recommend the abolition of the grade of Co-ordinating Officer, Rodrigues, against the creation of an additional post of Administrative Officer.

Executive Officer Cadre (formerly Executive Assistant Cadre)

4.6 The General Services grades of Rodrigues were granted different appellations compared to their counterparts in Mauritius mainly due to the different qualification requirements. As the qualification requirements for grades in Rodrigues are now similar to those prescribed in Mauritius, we are restyling the Executive Assistant Cadre to more appropriate job appellations in the salary schedule.

Principal Executive Officer (formerly Principal Executive Assistant)

4.7 One Principal Executive Officer combines the duties of head of the executive cadre and the responsibility for Personnel functions.

Recommendation 3

4.8 We recommend the payment of an allowance of Rs 1000 monthly to the Principal Executive Officer for combining duties as mentioned above.

FISHERIES

4.9 The grades in the Fisheries Protection Service in Rodrigues are being restyled in line with their counterparts in Mauritius.

Recommendation 4

4.10 We recommend the restyling of the grades of Fisheries Assistant, Senior Fisheries Assistant, Fisheries Protection Officer and Senior Fisheries Protection Officer to Fisheries Protection Officer, Senior Fisheries Protection Officer, Principal Fisheries Protection Officer and Assistant Controller Fisheries Protection Service respectively.

4.11 We also recommend the creation of a new grade of Officer-in-Charge, Fisheries Protection Service to be promotional for officers in the grade of Assistant Controller Fisheries Protection Service on the basis of merit and experience.

5. Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office

PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE

Recruitment Procedures

5.1 It has been represented that the present system of recruitment for the grades of Tradesman Assistant and Foreman is made from among serving employees only and that outside candidates who have followed technical courses from recognised institutions are thus barred from entry in the service. In view of the specificity of Rodrigues, it is felt that the recruitment procedures should be less rigid.

Recommendation 1

5.2 We recommend that recruitment for the grade of Tradesman Assistant be opened also for candidates from outside the service who have successfully followed technical courses in the relevant fields at the IVTB, Lycee Polytechnique, College St Gabriel or any IVTB approved institutions.

Watchman - Caverne Patate

5.3 We are revising the allowance paid to the watchman, Caverne Patate.

Recommendation 2

5.4 We recommend that the allowance of Rs 250 monthly payable to the watchman posted at Caverne Patate be revised to Rs 325.

AGRICULTURAL SERVICES

5.5 Officers in the grades of Technical Officer, Field Assistant, Senior Technical Assistant, Agricultural Assistant and Agricultural Trainee performing extension work are regularly required to work outside normal working hours to deliver talks and perform demonstrations to farmers. We are addressing the issue.

Recommendation 3

5.6 We recommend that Management should introduce flexitime as soon as possible for officers working in the Extension Unit of the Agricultural Services in accordance with the recommendations made in the relevant chapter of Volume I of this Report.

6. Commissioner for Health, Cooperatives, Prisons and Reforms Institutions and Fire Services

MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Medical Superintendent

6.1 Following the creation of the grade of Health Director, the role and functions of the Medical Superintendent have been taken over by the latter grade and the post is vacant. We are, therefore, recommending the abolition of the grade of Medical Superintendent.

Recommendation 1

6.2 We recommend the abolition of the grade of Medical Superintendent.

Health Director

6.3 Taking into consideration the enhanced responsibilities of the Health Director, we are recommending payment of an allowance to the officer.

Recommendation 2

6.4 We recommend the payment of an allowance to the Health Director to bring his salary to the level of a Regional Health Director. We further recommend that this allowance should be taken into account to compute the disturbance allowance.

Allowance to Doctors in Rodrigues

6.5 Doctors posted in Rodrigues are paid an allowance of Rs 80 per case for certifying the cause of death 'a domicile'.

Recommendation 3

6.6 We are revising the allowance paid to doctors in Rodrigues for certifying the cause of death 'a domicile' to Rs 105 per case.

Post Mortem/Autopsy Examination

6.7 At present, Doctors in Rodrigues are paid an allowance of Rs 135 per case for post-mortem autopsy examination.

Recommendation 4

6.8 We recommend that the allowance paid to doctors in Rodrigues for postmortem autopsy examination be revised from Rs 135 to Rs 180 per case.

Senior Community Midwife

6.9 There are three posts of Community Midwife on the establishment of the Commission for Health, Prisons and Reforms Institution, Cooperatives and Fire Services. The seniormost officer is called upon to organise work, submit reports and generally to perform the duties of a Senior Community Midwife. We are creating a senior grade to take charge of these responsibilities.

Recommendation 5

- 6.10 We recommend the creation of a grade of Senior Community Midwife to be filled by promotion from officers in the grade of Community Midwife with at least three years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade.
- 6.11 The Senior Community Midwife would be responsible for the proper staffing of the health centers in respect of midwives, supervising the work of Community Midwives and preparing their duty roster, preparing health education programmes about midwifery and child health to meet the needs of the community in specific areas and participating in these programmes among other duties.

Head Catering Unit (New Grade)

6.12 With a view to upgrading the quality of catering services in Rodrigues, there is need to create a new grade of Head Catering Unit.

Recommendation 6

- 6.13 We recommend the creation of a new grade of Head Catering Unit to be filled by selection from among officers in the grade of Catering Supervisor who reckon at least five years service in their respective grades. The selected candidate would be appointed in a temporary capacity for a period of not less than six months.
- 6.14 The Head Catering Unit would be responsible, among others, for organising and controlling the day-to-day work of the catering services of hospitals; ordering, receiving and distributing provisions and food; maintaining a high level of cleanliness and hygiene in the preparation and handling of food and in the kitchen; exercising strict control to avoid waste and pilferage in the kitchen; planning the menu and exercising control on the quality and cost of food prepared and its service to patients and staff.

Allowance

6.15 Nursing officers attached to the operation theatre are required to be on call after office hours and to attend work whenever there are emergency operations carried out after official hours. They are presently paid the Bank Nurse Allowance when they are called for duty after office hours.

Recommendation 7

6.16 We are maintaining the present system.

Medical Laboratory Services (Rodrigues)

6.17 Medical Laboratory Technicians and Senior Medical Laboratory Technicians in Rodrigues hospital provide emergency laboratory services during nights, weekends and public holidays in an "on-call" system and are paid allowances for being "on-call" and for attendance during "on-call". The present arrangement should continue.

Recommendation 8

1.6.18 We recommend that Medical Laboratory Technicians and Senior Medical Laboratory Technicians in Rodrigues hospital who are required to be "on call" and to attend to emergencies during nights, weekends and public holidays be paid allowances as hereunder:

On-Call/In Attendance Allowance (Rodrigues)

6.19 At present an emergency Radiography (diagnostic) service at the Radiography Unit in Rodrigues is provided during nights, weekends and public holidays in an "on-call" system. A Radiographer or a Senior Radiographer who remains on call after a normal day's work is paid an "on-call" allowance and for attendance during on call is paid "in attendance" allowance. We are maintaining the present arrangement and reviewing the allowances.

Recommendation 9

6.20 We recommend that Radiographers and Senior Radiographers in Rodrigues Hospital who are required to be "on-call" and to attend to emergencies during nights, weekends and public holidays should be paid allowances as hereunder:

Screening Allowance (Rodrigues)

6.21 The Radiography Staff serving in Rodrigues carries out screening examinations in the absence of Radiologist. At present the screening allowance is Rs 55 per case. We are revising this allowance.

Recommendation 10

6.22 We recommend that officers of Radiographer cadre in Rodrigues performing screening examinations in the absence of a Radiologist be paid a screening allowance of Rs 65 per case.

Senior Radiographic Assistant (New Grade)

- 6.23 There are two Radiographic Assistants on the establishment of the X-Ray Unit of the Queen Elizabeth Hospital. The duties of providing simple statistics, giving appointments and instructions for special X-Ray examination, ensuring cleanliness and upkeep and issue of gowns to female patients are those of a Senior Radiographic Assistant. However, in Rodrigues, the seniormost Radiographic Assistant is compelled to perform both duties for the smooth running of the service.
- 6.24 In the light of the above, we are recommending the creation of a new grade of Senior Radiographic Assistant.

Recommendation 11

6.25 We recommend the creation of a new grade of Senior Radiographic Assistant to be filled by promotion from among officers in the grade of Radiographic Assistant.

FIRE SERVICES

Head Officer

6.26 The Head Officer of the Fire Services is paid an *ad hoc* allowance to attend to emergencies. He is also responsible for fire safety and oil spillage at the harbour. We are revising the allowance.

Recommendation 12

6.27 We recommend that the allowance presently paid to the Head Officer Fire Services be increased to Rs 1000 monthly.

Scheme of Service

Recommendation 13

6.28 We recommend that the scheme of service of the Rodriguan Fire personnel should be amended to include duties related to fire safety and oil spillage in Port Mathurin.

CO-OPERATIVES

6.29 In view of the number of Cooperative societies in Rodrigues, the Principal Cooperative Officer is performing administrative and management duties at a higher level. We are recommending the restyling of the grade to Officer-in-Charge, Cooperatives to reflect the nature of his duties.

Recommendation 14

- 6.30 We recommend the restyling of the grade of Principal Co-operative Officer to Officer-in-Charge, Co-operatives.
- 7. Commissioner For Youth And Sports, Industrial Development And Handicraft And Trade, Commerce And Licensing

YOUTH AND SPORTS

Sports Coordinating Officer

7.1 The Sports Coordinating Officer is presently in charge of the Sports Division. However, two posts of Sports Officers have been created to reinforce the cadre and provide professional expertise. We are providing a personal salary to the present Sports Coordinating Officer.

Recommendation 1

7.2 We recommend that the grade of Sports Coordinating Officer be abolished on vacancy. We are providing a personal salary to incumbent.

Sports Coach

7.3 Sports Coaches are required to work regularly at irregular hours for which they are neither given time off nor remunerated financially. The Bureau considers that they should be duly compensated in one form or another.

Recommendation 2

7.4 We recommend that Sports Coaches who have to put in extra hours of work should be given equivalent time off for the extra hours put in. Where it has not been possible for management to grant time off within a period of six consecutive months, a request should be made to the Ministry of Civil Service Affairs and Administrative Reforms through the Chief Executive for the payment of an appropriate allowance as compensation for the extra hours.
