

PROCUREMENT POLICY OFFICE

- 18.11.47 The Procurement Policy Office (PPO), an independent body established under the Public Procurement Act 2006, is responsible to ensure transparency, fairness and efficiency in procurement activities. Its key roles include policy formulation, monitoring and facilitating improvements of the procurement system as well as catering for training programmes for public officials, contractors and suppliers on procurement procedures. The PPO also communicates and cooperates with international institutions and other foreign entities on matters relating to procurement.
- 18.11.48 The administration of the PPO is statutorily vested in the Director and two independent members appointed by the President of the Republic. They are assisted in their tasks by officers of the Procurement and Supply Cadre, Analyst/Senior Analysts, General Services and other supporting grades.
- 18.11.49 In the context of this review, the Bureau did not receive any submission from Management. On the basis of information available, it is considered that the existing set-up is appropriate for enabling the PPO to deliver on its mandate.
